Chromium is one of the most notable ingredients. The European Union permits specific health claims for chromium, including that chromium contributes to normal macronutrient metabolism and the maintenance of normal blood glucose levels. MedicGLP provides 100 mcg of chromium per capsule, equivalent to 250% of the EU nutrient reference value.

The formula also contains berberine and green tea extract. Berberine has been studied for blood glucose, lipid metabolism, and body weight, although the National Center for Complementary and Integrative Health notes that evidence for weight loss remains inconclusive and that study doses and formulations vary considerably.

Therefore, it is more accurate to describe MedicGLP as a **metabolic-support supplement** than to claim that it directly causes weight loss or produces the same effects as prescription GLP-1 drugs.

The manufacturer's current ingredient list includes the following per one-capsule daily serving:

- Chromium (chromium picolinate) – 100 mcg:** A trace mineral involved in normal macronutrient metabolism and normal blood glucose maintenance.

- Green tea leaf extract – 154 mg:** A botanical source of catechins and naturally occurring caffeine.

One positive feature of the manufacturer's current presentation is that it lists individual ingredient quantities rather than hiding them behind a proprietary blend.

Potential Benefits

Potential benefits of **MedicGLP Metabolic Balance** should be viewed realistically.

The formula is intended to complement healthy eating, exercise, and other lifestyle habits. Chromium contributes to normal macronutrient metabolism and normal blood glucose maintenance, while some of the botanical ingredients have been studied individually for various metabolic effects.

Berberine is particularly interesting because research has investigated its possible effects on blood glucose, insulin resistance, cholesterol, and body weight. However, current evidence does not establish that the specific MedicGLP formula produces clinically meaningful weight loss. According to the manufacturer's directions, the recommended serving is **one capsule per day with water**. One bottle contains 30 capsules, corresponding to approximately 30 days of use.

Do not exceed the recommended serving. Supplements should complement—not replace—a varied diet, adequate physical activity, sleep, and other healthy habits.

Customer Reviews

Green tea also naturally contains caffeine, which can contribute to nervousness, shakiness, or sleep disturbances in sensitive individuals.

Because of the berberine content, the manufacturer advises against use during pregnancy and breastfeeding. People under 18 are also not the intended users.

If you experience an unusual or serious reaction after taking any supplement, discontinue use and seek appropriate medical advice.

According to the manufacturer's current website, MedicGLP is sold directly online rather than through major retail pharmacies.

Its main selling point is convenience: a single daily capsule combines a range of nutritional and botanical ingredients. Chromium has recognized EU health claims related to normal macronutrient metabolism and blood glucose maintenance, while ingredients such as berberine and green tea have been investigated for metabolic and weight-related effects. However, the evidence should not be overstated, and MedicGLP should not be confused with prescription GLP-1 medication.

The biggest considerations are the limited independent evidence on the finished product, the relatively small amount of independent customer feedback, and the potential for side effects or interactions from ingredients such as berberine and green tea extract.
